Background to Learning

Children will learn to review and learn about shapes, they will improve their cutting and gluing skills. They learn about collage by creating their own collages using beads and paper and make their own beaded collages.

Content of Lesson

The idea of this lesson is to teach children about texture and sticking 3d objects onto paper. The children will make their own collages and then will put all of the collages together to make one big collage.

Instructions:

The children will need to be sitting around a table. There needs to be the right equipment spread out for them and it needs to be accessible for them to reach when they need. The children must be free and the teacher should not tell them to do things a certain way.

The equipment will all be in the centre of the table.
